




Every year, 1,465 tonnes of microfibres - the equivalent weight of 5,426 grizzly bears - are released into the Canadian environment from home laundry.



Home laundry emissions estimated from Vassilenko et al. (2021) at 219 cycles per household per year (NRC, 2011). Air emissions estimated from Tao et al. (2021). Release estimates from a WWTP retention rate of 86% (Sun et al., 2019), and proportions of biosolid treated, used and disposed (CH2MHII Canada, 2000). Estimates of environmental releases include additional untreated wastewater releases of approximately 35 tonnes.
